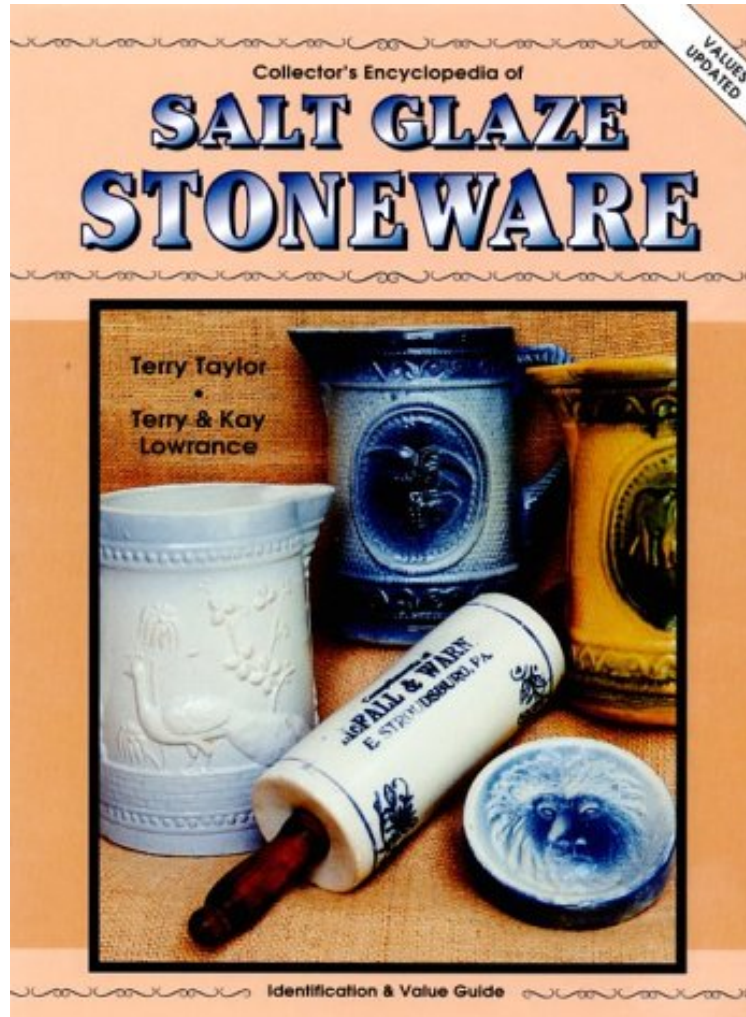

Artwork, flowers, birds, etc. decorations are usually molded into these pieces. Most illustrated stoneware is first covered with white glaze and then with additional diffuse colored glaze usually blue. Some pieces use various solid colored glazes. A few illustrated pieces use stamped blue decoration over white glaze. This book, however, does not really deal with true salt glaze, hand decorated pottery prior to 1900. For

The term "salt glaze" is readily used when describing these pieces. Because of its common use as a term for this colorful molded stoneware, it can be endorsed as a generic name for these pieces of "factory made" wares.
