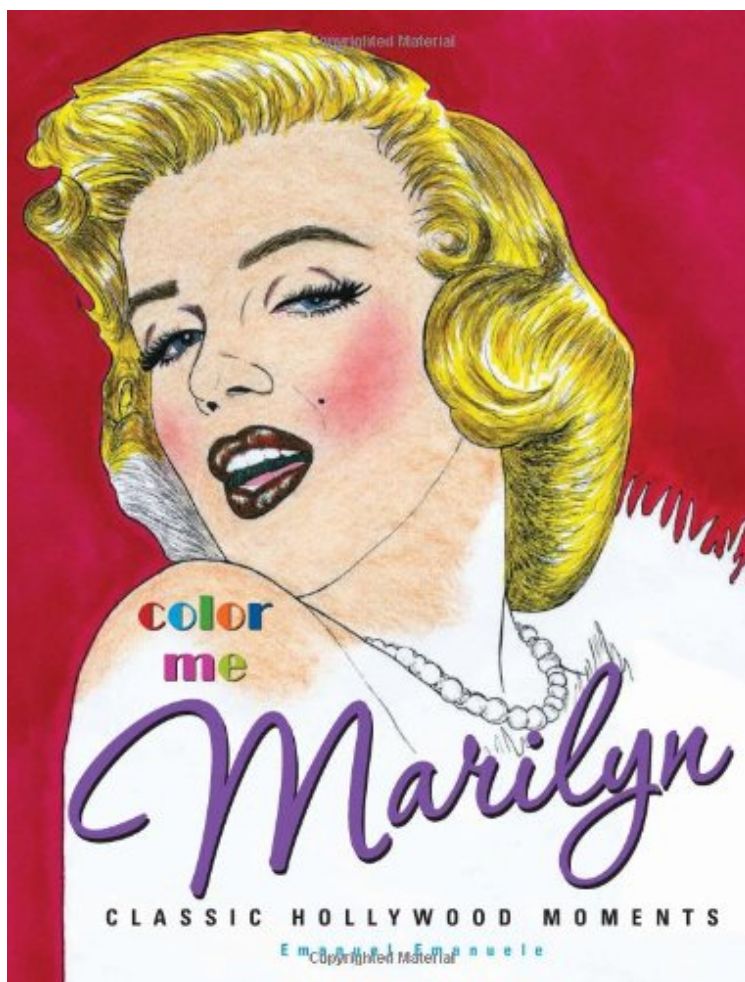

Color Marilyn Make Her MerryBy thirdtwinGood for practicing your skin tones for your own art projects even if you're not a fan; since there is black ink filled in on many spots you will have to color over it with a light base coat that completely covers the black ink before you can make all your own color choices- an irritation but it is possible to do if you use the right medium or if you use many layers of colored pencil. So in general colored pencils work best on this for the parts not filled in with black ink- for those you'll probably want to do a white under coat in pen or marker then use compatible pencils over top of that if you have the time and interest. If you layer over the black ink you can color the lips red or ink instead of black- for example- but you have to use and undercoat to obscure the black ink that comes pre-printed first. It's a little time consuming but it

The paper is a poor quality printer type, and only suitable for colored pencils. Also the artist decided to make all her lips black. This leaves no room for using corals, pinks, or reds. I feel this was a very poor decision on his part. The pictures appear to be copies of photographs, which is no problem. I am just not happy with the quality of the book for the price. I would like to add that I just colored two of the pictures in this book. The drawings are excellent, and there are a great variety of pictures. I am finding that the less expensive colored pencils work very well on this paper. Ex. Crayola, Prang, Rose Art etc. Prisma colored pencils seem to grab and do not go as smoothly as I would like. Experiment and have fun. (note: I have gone over the "black" lips with a white Sakura gel pen, and cannot color her lips any color I choose.)
