

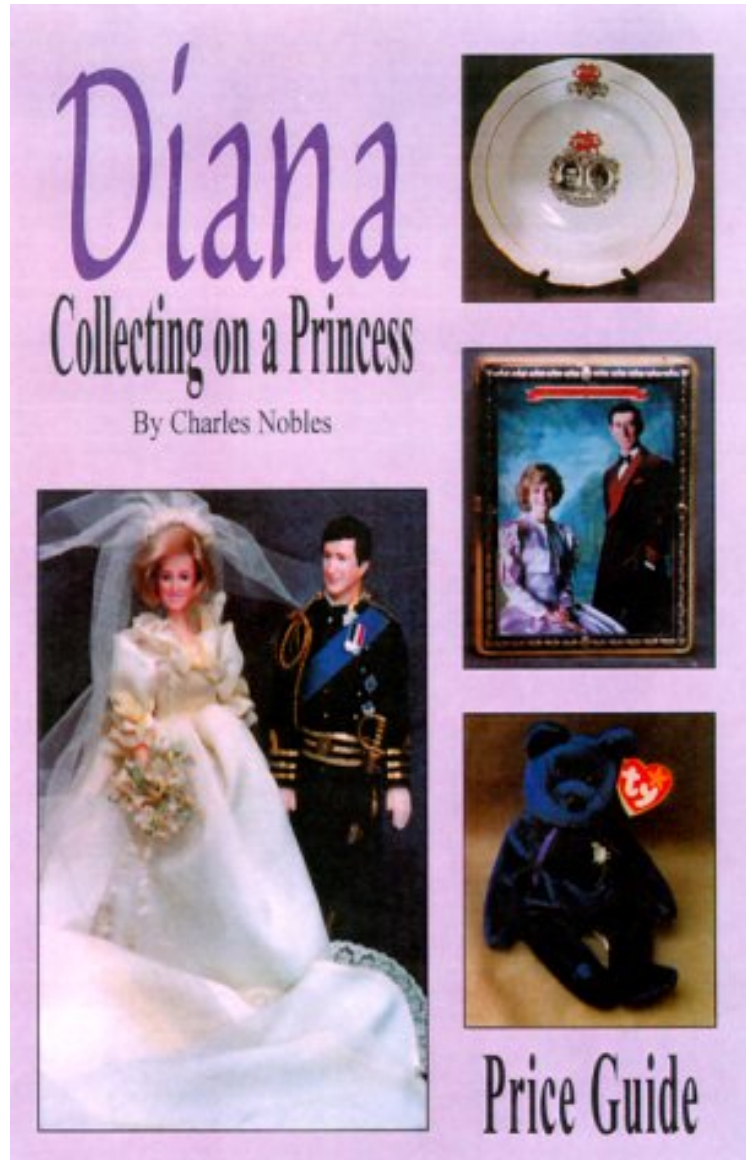

Mr. Nobles and his collection have been in the media numerous times. He was interviewed for USA Today and articles about him appeared on the AP Wire service. He was featured on the FX series "Personal FX, The Collectibles Show" as a super collector. He was one of the few chosen to attend the Christies' "Auction of Dresses from the collection of Diana, Princess of Wales." Mr. Nobles lives in Myrtle Beach, SC, and continues to increase his collection. He plans to donate a portion of the proceeds from this book to Careteam, a local AIDS support organization.
