

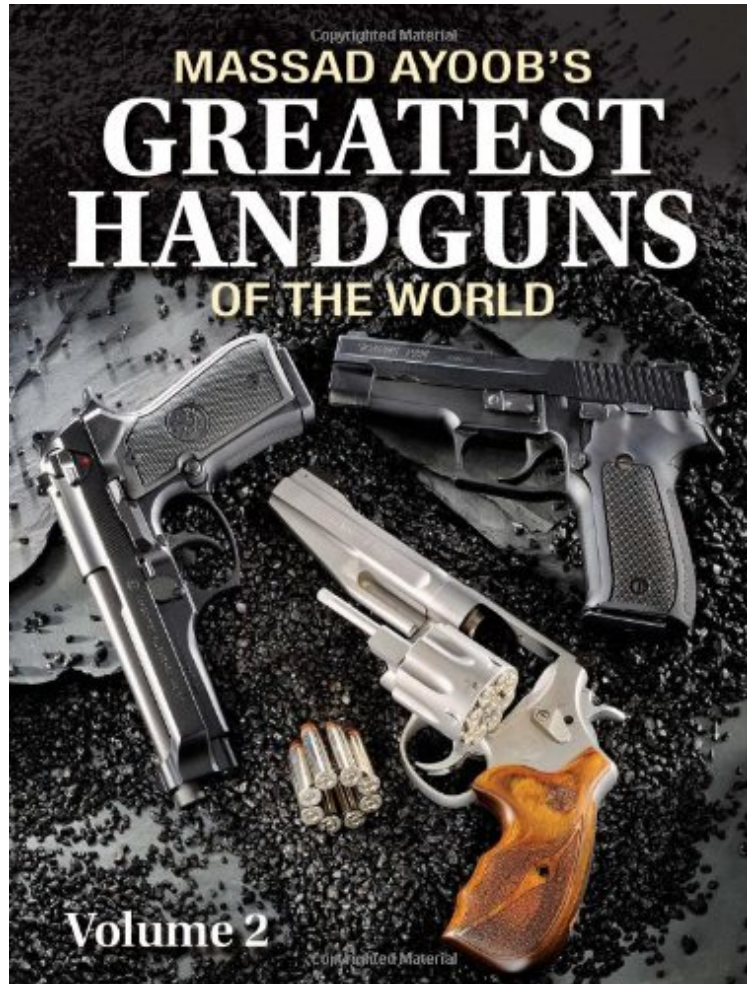

Struckman Massad did a much better job limiting the typos and mistakes in this volume, but I found some of his chosen handguns a bit off the beaten path and some of the material just wasn't up to his normally excellent standard. Since both this book and it's predecessor are merely compilations of articles he had previously wrote, be prepared to read the same thing, over and over, such as his method discounting the two worst shots in a 5 shot group and using the remaining 3 for an approximation of what a gun would do in a rest.
