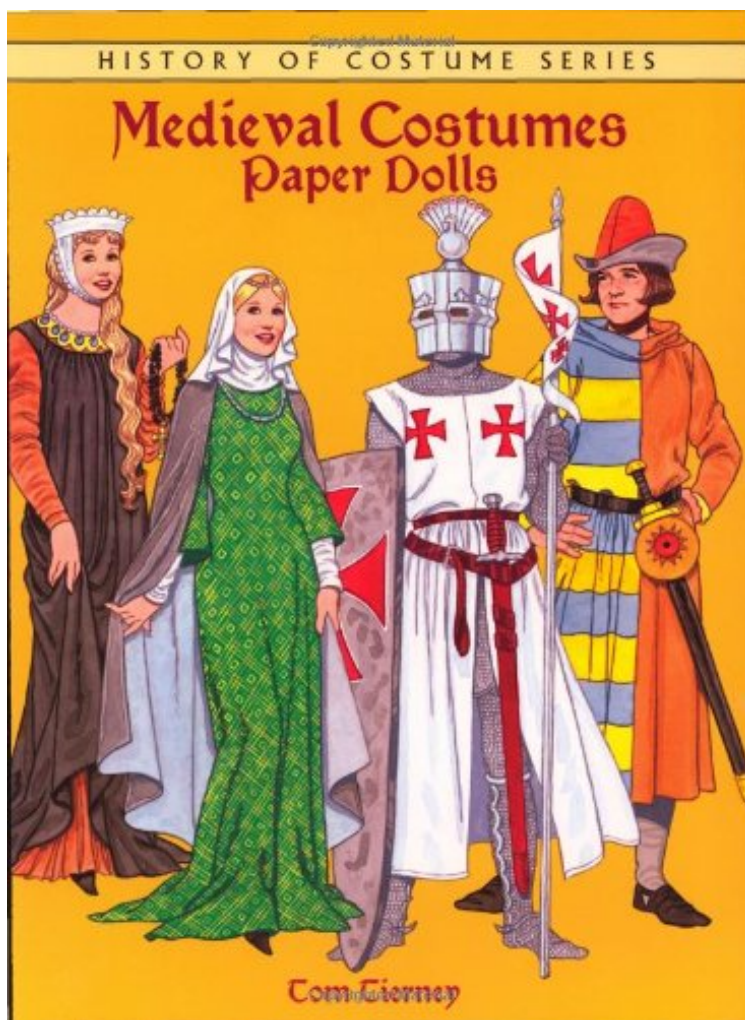

There are two paper dolls included. The only negative thing is that it doesn't have perforated, precut pages and the tabs that hold the clothes on (in theory) are not large enough or sturdy enough to hold the costumes on in reality. The small tabs and finely detailed costume edges were difficult for my daughter to cut out and about halfway through the book she gave up. This book would have benefited from being printed on thicker paper to make things sturdier. Having said that the costumes are beautiful.
