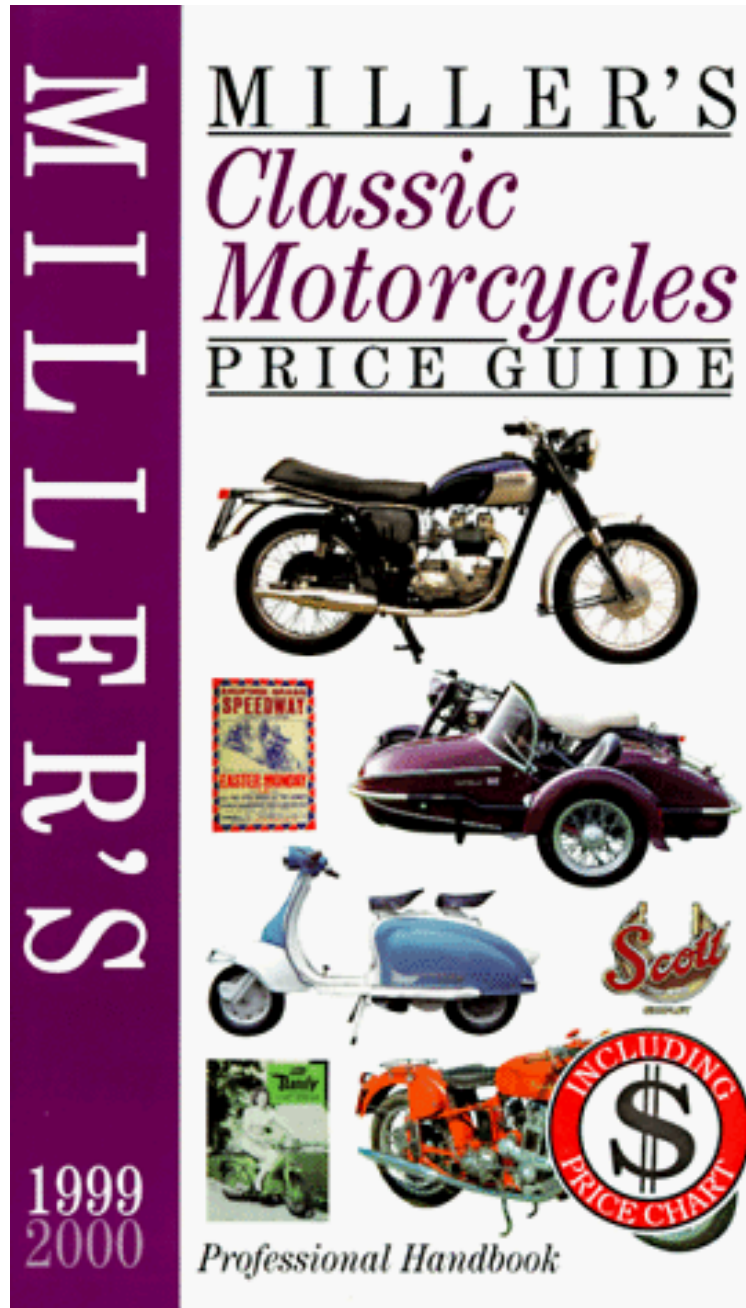

For classic bike seekers - a fine referenceBy Amnon IRMAYFor the international classic-motorcycle-collector this is a comprehensive book on the different antique and classic bikes that are available in the European market, mainly in the UK. It covers mostly the known models in detail, sometimes lacking in the more popular ones. The pricing of the Guide is based on the British market but as far as I could compare to the actual values I encountered - there are differences (but that may be acceptable). The model pricing doesn't take in account the condition of the bike and in some cases its availability (and market demand), but is fair. I found it very useful (as the managing secretary of the Israel Classic Collectors Vehicle Club) in aiding many of our members to value their purchases from abroad and while searching for finds in other European countries - with a very good feedback on most parts. The book is also a good reference for details on rare bikes and models, although it is far from being an encyclopedia or an official reference book.

Now in its sixth year, Miller's Classic Motorcycles Price Guide features over 75 marques of classic pre-1981 motorcycles, including vintage, veteran and restoration projects. This year there are extended features on sidecars, scooters and the popular British Triumph marque. There is a wealth of collecting information, with details of models and makers, and each picture is accompanied by a price range, description and date - all authenticated by best-selling author Mick Walker. There is also a section on motorcycle memorabilia, featuring books, posters and medals. With invaluable information - from a review of the market over the last year to advice on color schemes and paint finishes - and a comprehensive reference section, Miller's Classic Motorcycle Price Guide has become an essential handbook for those interested in motorcycles, either professionally or for pleasure.
