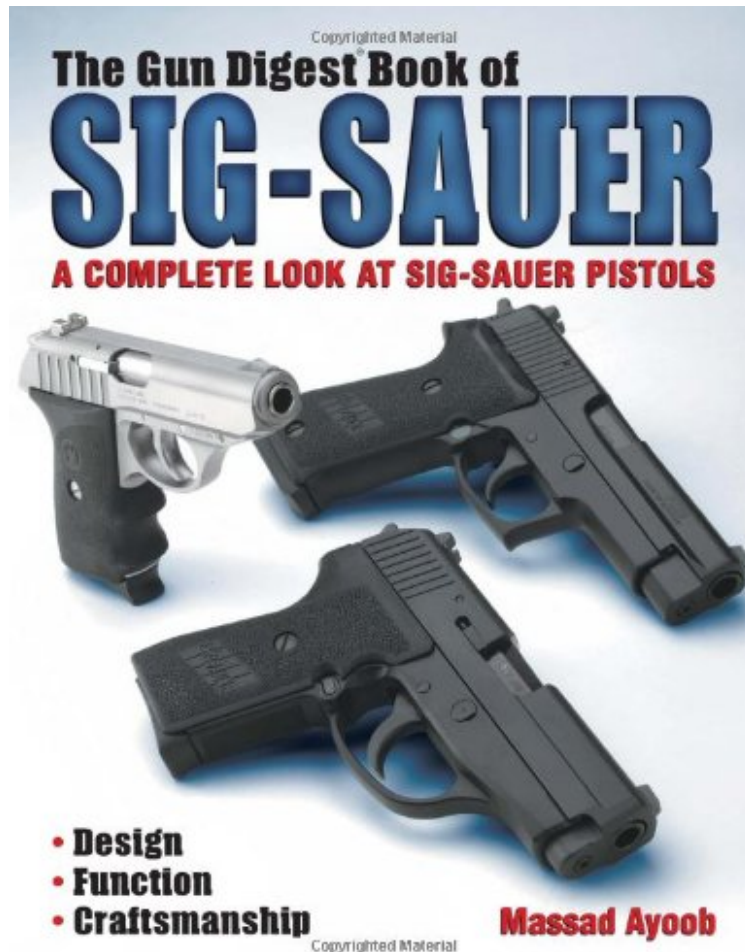

That speaks well of the fact that this book is still a valuable reference work in the world of firearms. Secondly, it definitely needs updating. I have to dock it one star due to the need for a new edition.Ayoob is a good writer, probably the best of the bunch currently. He makes no bones of the fact that the SIG P220 is his favorite model and the SIG P230/232 is his least favorite. He offers lots of objective information about SIGs as well as his own well-based opinions on secondary

subjects. There is some redundancy, especially the quotations of other writers who have reviewed SIG pistols. Mostly, these sources just repeated information about the gun that Ayoob had already presented in the text at hand. Included are sections on training and competition that prove interesting and useful. Ayoob, having a long history in law enforcement, weighs the use of the SIG models heavily in that direction. Overall, this is a useful reference on SIG-Sauer handguns, one of the very few available. Unfortunately, being a Krause/Gun Digest publication, you will find poor photography reproduction and some instances of bad editing. Happily, most of Ayoob's books have fewer typos and instances of errors and poor editing than the usual Gun Digest book.
