

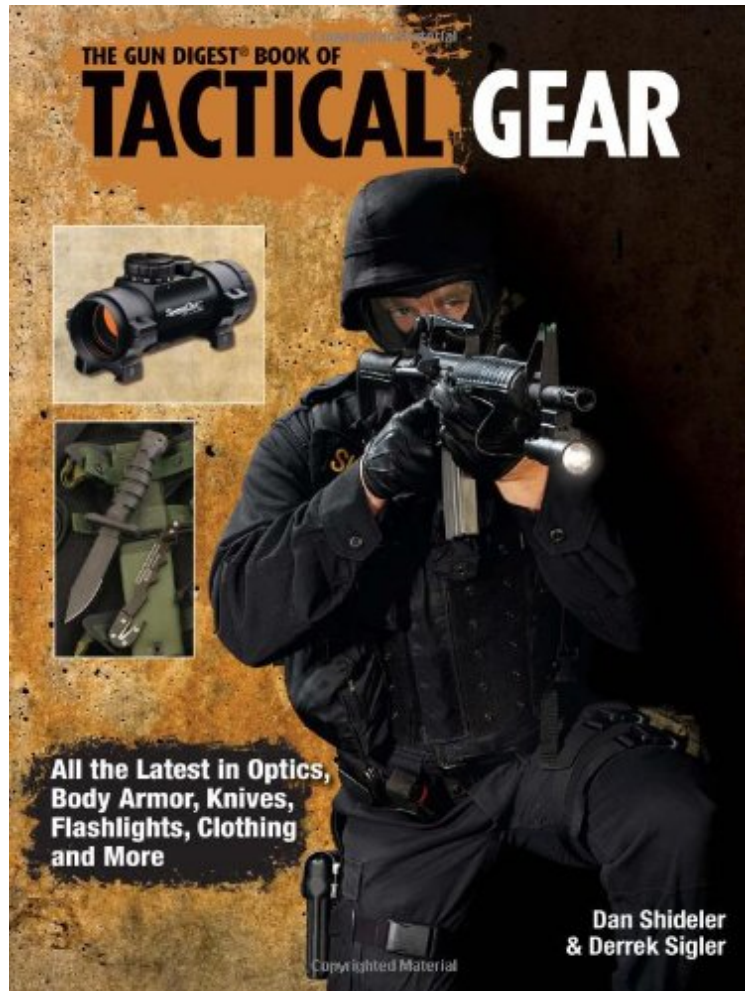

The book, frankly, is lazily researched and very outdated even with it's publishing in 2008. They don't really cover 'tactical gear' until the last 20 or so pages and spends the rest of the time giving you sloppily organized information on handguns and carbines. Most of the information is conjecture and written for someone who doesn't know any better. You could gain much better info on all topics covered simply from web crawling for a few weeks on the popular firearm sites. The sections are rarely concise and usually end in a price list of sorts of items and weapons with poor descriptions that don't give you the info you need. The fact that the optics section doesn't mention Aimpoint or that the carbine manufacturers section doesn't mention LMT, LaRue, or Bravo Company is atrocious. I give it 2 because I rather enjoyed the section of the 'history' of hard use tacti-cool knives, and because there is occasionally and interesting tidbit and I bought it for 8 bucks.
